This is a valuable opportunity to gain insight into an effective, well-regarded nonprofit environmental organization. Key tasks will include:

- Assist with implementation of the monthly High Desert Speaker Series, including managing attendance lists via EventBrite
- Capture and organize event results in ONDA's Salesforce database
- Manage event logistics, including organizing materials, recruiting volunteers, soliciting sponsors, and completing promotions to drive turn out
- Recruit new supporters and provide information about conservation opportunities at ONDA outreach events
- Plan and potentially lead guided hikes from Portland in partnership with volunteer naturalists
